Cllr Ward, the Lead Member of the Corporate Development and Audit Working Group, explained that a review had taken place of the Council's Branding and explained that the Town Council had, over a number of years, accumulated a number of different brands which identified the Town Council. Some the brands were recognisable and some were less effective.

PRECEPT

Total Income from Council Tax 2009/10

The Council Tax bill paid by Farnham residents based on 16,978.5 average band D Households in 2009/10 was £51.06 per year. This produced a Total Council Tax income of £866,976.

Total Income from Council Tax 2010/11

The Average band D Household's Tax Base for 2010/11has increased to 17,155.1 households.

If the Council chooses to leave the Council Tax for an average band D household unchanged at £51.06 for 2010/11, this would give the Town Council a total income from Council Tax of £875,939

There will be a small shortfall of £2,800 to be identified from additional budget savings or from General Reserves.

The Council are required to make a decision at this meeting to inform Waverley Borough Council by 22 January 2010

Appeal by: TAG Farnborough Airport Ltd.

Proposal: Variation of condition 8 of planning permission (reference APP/P1750/A/06/2024640 issued by the Secretaries of State on 13 March 2008) to allow an increase in the total number of business aviation movements from 28,000 to a maximum of 50,000 movements per annum, including an increase in the number of business aviation movements at weekends and Bank Holidays from 5,000 to 8,900 per annum. **Location: Farnborough Airport, Farnborough Road, Farnborough**

An appeal has been lodged by TAG Farnborough Airport Ltd. against the decision by the Council to refuse permission for the above proposal. Details of the appellant's grounds of appeal can be inspected at the Council Offices during normal office hours, and can be found on the Council's website at www.rushmoor.gov.uk. The appeal will be dealt with by an Inspector from the Planning Inspectorate and will involve a Public Inquiry. The date for the Public Inquiry has not yet been set. After the inquiry, the Inspector will report to the Secretaries of State for Communities and Local Government and Transport, who will make the final decision

You are entitled to attend the Public Inquiry and, with the Inspector's permission, you may be invited to speak. In the meantime however, you can make representations about this appeal. The Council has already sent copies of all comments that were made at the application stage to the Planning Inspectorate and the Inspectorate advise that you need not make any further comments. However, if you wish to modify, elaborate or withdraw any earlier comments, you will need to send 3 copies of your letter direct to the Inspectorate. Unless specifically asked, the Inspectorate will not acknowledge your letter. They will however pass your letter to the Inspector dealing with the appeal. Please ensure that the Planning Inspectorate receives your comments by 02 March 2010 otherwise they will not be considered. Rushmoor Plan Consultation – the Core Strategy and the Farnborough Airport Area Action Plan

The Council is currently reviewing its planning policies and to this end, is preparing a series of documents that will together replace the Rushmoor Local Plan Review 1996 – 2011. These documents will be known as the Rushmoor Plan.

The Council is working on two key documents as part of the Rushmoor Plan; the Core Strategy and the Farnborough Airport Area Action Plan. You may have already been involved in the preparation of either or both of these through responding to previous consultations, writing letters or emails, or meeting and speaking with Officers in the Planning Policy Team.

You will also have received a letter relating to a planning appeal by TAG against the Council's decision to refuse planning permission to allow an increase in the number of annual air traffic movements. The planning appeal and the preparation of new long term planning policies are two separate issues. However, as the Council is consulting over 10,000 people in Rushmoor and adjacent Borough's on both of these issues it was considered financially prudent to combine the postal processes. Please respond separately to the Planning Inspectorate in relation to the planning appeal if you wish to do so.

Using feedback from previous consultations, along with further background research and evidence gathering, the Council has prepared the next version of the Core Strategy and Area Action Plan. They are known as the "Preferred Approach", and set out the Council's preferred policies on various planning issues. They explain the reason for the preferred policies, but also detail other options that were considered but not deemed to be so appropriate.

The Council is publishing the Core Strategy Preferred Approach document and the Farnborough Airport Area Action Plan Preferred Approach document for six weeks between **18 January 2010 and 1 March 2010** to seek your views on them. We want to know whether you agree with the preferred policies, would prefer any of the other options identified, or in fact wish to suggest a different approach.

The documents, along with supporting background information, are available to view on the Council's web site at: <u>www.rushmoor.gov.uk/rushmoorplan</u>. The web site explains how you can make on-line comments and we hope that you will find it easy to use. By submitting your response on-line, this will help to save paper where possible. However, you can also make you comments by emailing them to: <u>plan@rushmoor.gov.uk</u>, or by writing to the Planning Policy Team at the address given at the top of this letter, ideally using the comments form available as part of this consultation.

Paper copies of the documents, including the response form, are available to view at the Borough's libraries and the Council offices. Copies have also been placed at the main Council offices for Hart, Surrey Heath, Woking, Waverley and Guildford Boroughs.

During the consultation, we will be running a series of "Meet the Planner" events in Aldershot and Farnborough. For details of dates and times of these events, please visit <u>www.rushmoor.gov.uk/rushmoorplan</u>, or contact the Planning Policy Team using the details given at the top of this letter.

Once we have received your comments, we will use them to help prepare the next version of the Core Strategy and the Farnborough Airport Area Action Plan, which will begin to look more like how we would expect the final version of these documents to read. These will be available for further comment in the Autumn of 2010, after which they will be submitted to the Secretary of State for independent Examination.

If you would like any further information on the consultation, please do not hesitate to contact the Planning Policy Team. We look forward to receiving your comments by the closing date of **1 March 2010**. Equally, if you no longer wish to receive correspondence on this matter, please contact the Planning Policy Team to request removal from the Local Development Framework contact database.

The Town Council is required to hold a minimum of three Full Council meetings a year plus the Annual Council meeting.

The Town Council must hold Council meetings to comply with statutory requirements.
