FULL STEAM AHEAD!

Despite the delay in Waverley's [Local Development Plan \(Core Strategy\)](#), which has now been withdrawn, the Farnham Neighbourhood Plan is being progressed, in the hope that a full consultation document will be ready in Spring 2014.

Next Steps

Following the roaming exhibitions, the Steering Group will address comments received in a "Consultation Draft". This will be subject to a public workshop on 13th November at 7.30pm at the [Farnham Maltings](#). Email neighbourhood.plan@farnham.gov.uk or call 01252 712667 if you wish to attend so that the necessary housekeeping arrangements can be made.

Any further comments received at the workshop will be reviewed and addressed and the Consultation Draft will be finalised with support from an external advisor who will be asked to assist the Neighbourhood Plan Team when preparing this draft. An independent review of the plan will later be conducted by [NPIERS \(Neighbourhood Plan Independent Examiner Referral Service\)](#), prior to submission of the document to the Local Planning Authority (LPA), Waverley Borough Council.

The proposed Neighbourhood Plan will be checked against statutory criteria, e.g. that proper procedures have been followed in its preparation and that any necessary assessments accompany the plan. Following a period of publicity, the LPA will arrange for an independent examination and organise the public referendum, subject to the plan meeting all legal requirements.
