All persons must leave the area where the judging is to take place with the exception of officials directly concerned with the show.

All exhibits should be washed and prepared before entry.

All exhibits must remain in place until the presentation of awards is complete.

Show Classes

General

All produce must be grown by the person entering

I plate of either 3 carrots, 3 onions, 3 garlic or 3 leeks

I plate of six potatoes of uniform size

I plate showing I bunch of tomatoes on the vine

A selection of salad crop items on a plate e.g. lettuce, cucumber, radish, tomato

3 squash of uniform size and shape e.g. courgettes, patty squash, pumpkin

Posy of herbs in a vase

6 sweet peas of uniform length in vase or container

3 dahlia flowers in vase or container

Cottage garden arrangement of flowers in vase or container

A plate of 10 soft fruit e.g. raspberries

A plate of 4 stoned fruit e.g. plum, apple, damson

A humorous vegetable character

Children or grandchildren of allotment holders

Funniest fruit/vegetable

Submit a piece of fruit or vegetable and adorn with accessories if wanted. Name your entry.

A4 drawing or painting of a flower or flowers

A4 art work using plant material

Posy of home grown flowers - presented in a jam jar

Baking

Bread - one loaf

Scones or Biscuits- one plate of 5

Cake

Fruit Preserve - I jar - predominantly using produce from your allotment

Chutney/Pickle - I jar - predominantly using produce from your allotment
